Arrival at the Airport, our guests will be welcomed by our staff. Transfer to the hotel, along the way our tour leaders will entertain the guests with amenities about the local tradition, food and history. Check in at the hotel, a welcome brief for the guests will be set into their rooms before arrival, and also a small pillow-gift, something really typical such as an almond pastry. After a short free time we meet in the lobby and, escorted by our staff, proceed to dinner. Right before dinner, when everybody is seated, the guests will finally meet the **Godfather** and his trusted butler staging a hilarious duet, entertaining the guests before starters are served! Once dinner starts, the Godfather and the butler will leave the guests to their dinner, inviting them for the next day, in order to solve the mystery which is the main reason of their presence in Sicily. During dinner, special delivery into the rooms: a copy of a special pamphlet and a Mafioso hat for each guest. Overnight at the hotel, we'll meet again tomorrow morning.

Day 2: Mafia Games in the city.

In the morning, during breakfast at the hotel, distribution of the daily version of the pamphlet to the guests in the old style. After breakfast, wearing **Mafioso** hats, meet our game leaders at the hotel. The game leaders will explain to each team about the goals of the day and will hand over all necessary material and then off we go, let's start the game! We'll get to know better the city while playing our **team-building** game, for circa 3 hours, stopping for lunch and then giving a free afternoon for own discovery of the city, or shopping, or bar lounging... In the evening, dancing night with DJ, in exclusive area at the hotel or at an exclusively rent hall of a typical restaurant.

Day 3: Mount Etna Games.

During breakfast at the hotel, distribution of the daily version of the pamphlet to the guests in the old style. Then meet our staff introducing the theme of today: **Mount Etna**. The Etna has fascinated voyagers and inhabitants for ages, casting its portentous shade onto the villages and cities below, and we are going to visit it continuing our mafia games. It is the final day of our experience here in Sicily! Today we shall visit another town of Sicily. While we are having breakfast at the hotel distribution of the daily version of our pamphlet, in the old style. We then wear our **mafioso** hats and meet our game leaders at the hotel. Format Moviemaker event

An exciting program, mixing together team building activities, the thrill of an excursion to a lively volcano, a charity auction highlighting the social commitment of your company. An outstanding chance to enhance the feeling of being involved into something more than just an incentive trip!

DAY 1: Arrival, Welcome to Sicily.

Arrival at the Catania Airport, guests will be welcomed by our staff. During transfer from Catania airport to **Catania** city centre we shall welcome our guests and update them about the themes of the journey, introducing the activity thought up for today: an own visit of the main city and of a **fishermen village** nearby, by means of special roadmaps. This tour is important as it introduces the main theme of the third day. We reach the city centre and stop for a welcome drink into the main square; right after we split the group in teams and we consign the materials they need for this special visit, including cameras, discovering the locations of some famous Italian movies such as Malèna, Il Bell'Antonio, I Vicerè!

After this first visit we get on board of our bus again and move further to the second movie location, where **Luchino Visconti** shot "La terra Trema", in front of the sea and a very mythological area. Again guests will use our roadmaps and cameras until we are through and, on board of our bus, we reach the hotel, give free time to get acquainted and then have dinner at the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Fire & Wine.

In the morning, right after breakfast, you will be greeted at the hotel by our tour assistants and drivers. The group will be split in teams and we shall leave the hotel on board of jeeps.

The goal is to perform 2 activities: jeep tour and quad activity into the woods of the volcano.

We shall be based by a shelter on **Mount Etna**, into the pine-trees wood, which will also be our logistic base. We leave the hotel and reach the volcano, all jeeps will be radio-connected; then we leave the jeeps and shortly walk to the view point. From Monte Fontane one has an outstanding view of the Valle del Bove, giving the guests the possibility of understanding more of the nature of this volcano. We will then reach the Ragabo shelter, have a coffee break and a briefing to understand how a quad works, then we'll start our fun activity, with two people per quad, taking us into a 60 minutes drive into the woods. Guests will have to drive themselves for circa 30 minutes each, swapping position from passenger to driver, which helps a lot in building a feeling of trust in each other. After we are through with these 2 activities it will be about time to go for lunch, and we have a special place to take you to: it is a **winery** on the slopes of the volcano, we'll reach it in time to visit the production unit, the aging unit, and then of course have a lunch accompanied by different wines! After lunch we have thought up of one more activity, which can also be used as mean of aggregation: the teams will have to bottle their own bottles, put the cork and label the bottles manually, the old fashion way! In the end, all bottles have to be put into wooden individual boxes and they will be a nice present to take back home. Labels can be printed directly by the committing company or by us; in both cases they should bear the committing company logo. After we are through with all activities, we drive back to the hotel and give free time to freshen up and to dress up for tonight's dinner. Tonight we suggest dinner in an excellent **restaurant**! After dinner we drive back to the hotel for overnight.

DAY 3: Movie Makers at the Godfather locations.

After breakfast, we meet our tour leaders and drivers to be taken to our destinations of the day: Savoca and Forza D'Agrò, the locations of some of the most significant scenes of the **Godfather** Movies Trilogy! We shall split the teams on to different locations, and they will rotate after lunch time. One of the teams will reach **Savoca** while the other will reach Forza D'Agrò; both villages are quite stunning as they are both set on top of hills, with amazing views and fascinating narrow roads, old churches, real Sicilian villages as one expects them to be. Our gaming staff will introduce us to the art of movie making and the teams will be assigned their tasks. The activities will start, each participant will be given a task and they will have to work hands on the project: the filmic reproduction of significant scenes of the trilogy The Godfather! At break time they will meet and have lunch together. After lunch we swap destinations and, once we have achieved all our goals we say goodbye to our



gaming staff, reach our minibuses and drive back to our hotel. At the hotel we give free time to freshen up and dress up and then we reach our restaurant for tonight, a **Folk Restaurant**, with a welcome drink, a very good menu and our concluding show at gala dinner, a special awarding event for all participants. During the show, we also intend to introduce a charity auction, strictly tied to a local issue. Essentially, we intend to promote a national association which has been assigned, in Sicily and other Italian regions, the land and farmhouses that used to belong to definitely convicted mafia bosses. Among the tasks of this association, there is running of agricultural factories, also by means of employing former convicted for minor crimes, disabled people. We believe these associations are doing a fantastic job and deserve a helping hand. After dinner and dances we drive back to the hotel for overnight.

DAY 4: Goodbye to Sicily.

We had a great time here in **Sicily**, and we learned a lot about it...we have our buffet breakfast at the hotel, then check out and gather together for our transfer to the airport. Before departure, though, our staff will make the last special delivery: a copy of the material shot during the event for each participant, edited and with a soundtrack, for an enduring memory of an unforgettable experience! We say goodbye to everybody and get transferred to Catania airport, cherishing the memory of an unforgettable event.

ITALY Sicily - Multi sport event

A special active program made for special active people! While diving deeper into the natural environment of Sicily, you will find out the importance of being part of a team when it goes about achieving a target.

DAY 1: Welcome to Sicily.

At your arrival at the Airport, all guests will be welcomed by our tour leader and driver. Guests will then be transferred to the hotel in order to check in, have some free time to get acquainted. After free time we head to the hotel restaurant for a **welcome drink** and a welcome dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 2: Taormina (by sea and land).

After breakfast, we meet our tour leader and our driver to reach our embarkation harbour. Once there, we give go through a short briefing, then we embark on beautiful **sailing** boats. We start navigating, passing by the coast and stopping from time to time for pictures. We can also stop for a swim! We then navigate to **Isola Bella**, a wonder of nature at the foot of **Taormina**, where we shall stop for brunch, which will be served on board, along with drinks. After we are through with brunch we shall continue to the harbour, disembark and say goodbye to our skippers. We meet our driver and reach Taormina, one of the Pearls of the Mediterranean. We stop at the parking and reach the city. Once into the city centre, our tour leader will provide us with special roadmaps which will also include the guests' company logo, and we'll start an own visit of the city, discovering the most famous monuments at our own pace. There will also be a meeting point where we can refer to our tour leader. The activity will go on for circa 2,5 hours, we then meet again at the gathering point and proceed to our bus and reach the hotel. After free time to freshen up we head to our selected restaurant for a cosy dinner. After dinner, we drive back to the hotel for overnight.

DAY 3: Multisport on Mount Etna.

Right after breakfast, you will be greeted at the hotel by our tour assistant and drivers. Our target is to visit **Mount Etna** and offer a choice of 2 activities to our guests. The choice can be made between the below mentioned activities:

» Option 1: Canyoning & Off-road typical lunch in agritourism.

Pick up by Land Rover Defender 110 directly from the hotel. Arrival at the River **Alcantara**, dressing up and briefing. The technical equipment furnished includes a 5 mm neoprene suit, helmet, safety jacket, neoprene shoes. Guests will take their own swimming suit and sundeck towel. We start our activity. **Canyoning** is a multitask sport, a mix between swimming, climbing, gliding...the activity is performed into the gorges of River Alcantara, famous for its prismatic basaltic lava formations. It is really pure fun! The activity can be performed by each person with physical condition and the capacity to swim – so all in all it is available for almost everybody! We finish our activity, then we dress up with our own clothes again. We move further to an agritourism farm. Once there we shall have a typical Sicilian lunch with rural starters, pasta course, main meat course, dessert, fruit, water, wine and coffee. Once we are through with lunch, we relax a little and then start moving further, to the lava front of 2002. We reach the lava front and start the visit. The **lava** casting is really impressive, its start was announced by an earthquake in the night between 26 and 27 October 2002. We reach the Sartorius Mounts, extinct craters which used to be active until 1865, and after a simple walking excursion we are on top of the craters. After the walking excursion we start moving by **off-road vehicles** towards the Monte Fontane, leaving the regular roads and swapping them with an off-road track into the 1979 lava casting. We walk to the view point and enjoy the sight of the Valle del Bove, a valley left over by the collapse of the previous volcanoes Trifoglietto I and II, 65.000 thousand years ago. Once through with the walk to the view point we get back to the off-road vehicles for a tasting of almond pastries and sweet Sicilian wine. After the tasting we head to the hotel.

» Option 2: Mountain Biking & Canyoning typical lunch in agritourism.

Pick up by Land Rover Defender 110 directly from the hotel. We arrive at the base by the river and start the **bike** fitting (distribution of MBKs and fitting of the bicycles to the guests), followed by a briefing about the



activity and itinerary. The technical equipment includes an aluminium MBK with a 24 shifts gearbox and a safety helmet; we suggest the guests have their own bicycling pants and gym shoes. We start our biking activity, taking us along a suggestive route along river Alcantara, with views on the lava formations by the river, passing by Castiglione on the North side of Etna, also reaching a byzantine Kubbah. We'll pass by natural water sources along the way. The difference in height is quite low so the tour is accessible to all people in good shape. By the time we finish our activity we go through debriefing. We then transfer to an agritourism farm. Once there we shall have a typical **Sicilian lunch** with rural starters, pasta course, main meat course, dessert, fruit, water, wine and coffee. After lunch we relax a little, then have a briefing about canyoning. We move to our base by the river, once there we start dressing up. The technical equipment furnished includes a 5 mm neoprene suit, helmet, safety jacket, neoprene shoes. Guests will take their own swimming suit and sundeck towel. We start our second activity. **Canyoning** is a multitask sport, a mix between swimming, climbing, gliding...the activity is performed into the gorges of River Alcantara, famous for its prismatic basaltic lava formations. It is really pure fun! The activity can be performed by each person with physical condition and the capacity to swim – so all in all it is available for almost everybody! We finish the second activity and start dressing up with our own clothes, then we head to the hotel.

» **Option 3: Canyoning & Tarzaning typical lunch in agritourism.**

Pick up by Land Rover Defender 110 directly from the hotel. Arrival on the River Alcantara, dressing up and briefing. The technical equipment furnished includes a 5 mm neoprene suit, helmet, safety jacket, neoprene shoes. Guests will take their own swimming suit and sundeck towel. We start our activity. **Canyoning** is a multitask sport, a mix between swimming, climbing, gliding...the activity is performed into the gorges of River Alcantara, famous for its prismatic basaltic lava formations. It is really pure fun! The activity can be performed by each person with physical condition and the capacity to swim – so all in all it is available for almost everybody! Once we finish our activity we dress up with our own clothes again and move further to an agritourism farm. Once there we shall have a typical Sicilian lunch with rural starters, pasta course, main meat course, dessert, fruit, water, wine and coffee. We are through with lunch, we relax a little while getting briefed about next activity, tarzaning! After briefing we start the activity within the **adventure park** of the agritourism; the circuit is located on trees and it includes a Tibetan bridge, a Tyrolese bridge, the apes bridge, climbing test, the balance test...all activities are performed in maximum security as guests will be wearing a safety system with steel cable all the time. There is a total amount of maximum 15 workshops, according to the capacity of the guests. After the end of the activity we dress up with our own clothes, then head back to the hotel.

» **Option 4: Tarzaning & Off-road typical lunch in agritourism.**

Pick up by Land Rover Defender 110 directly from the hotel. We arrive at the adventure park into the agritourism, follows a briefing about the adventure park. After briefing we start our activity: the circuit is located on trees and it includes a Tibetan bridge, a Tyrolese bridge, the apes bridge, climbing test, the balance test...all activities are performed in maximum security as guests will be wearing a safety system with steel cable all the time. There is a total amount of maximum 15 **workshops**, according to the capacity of the guests. At the end of the activity we have a typical Sicilian lunch: rural starters, pasta course, main meat course, dessert, fruit, water, wine and coffee. By the end of lunch, we head to the 2002 eruption; we reach the lava front and start the visit. The lava casting is really impressive, its start was announced by an earthquake in the night between 26 and 27 October 2002. Right after we reach the Sartorius Mounts, extinct craters which used to be active until 1865, reaching the top after a simple walking excursion. After this pleasant walk we head towards the Monte Fontane by Land Rovers, leaving the regular roads and swapping them with an **off-road** track into the 1979 lava casting. We walk to the view point and enjoy the sight of the Valle del Bove, a valley left over by the collapse of the previous volcanoes Trifoglietto I and II, 65.000 thousand years ago. Once through with the walk to the view point we get back to the off-road vehicles for a tasting of almond pastries and sweet **Sicilian wine**. After the tasting we head back to the hotel. All above services will be performed by means of our specialized staff, with the aid of the tour leader. Once back at the hotel we suggest to freshen up, relax, then dress up for tonight's **gala dinner**, both at the hotel or in a local restaurant.

DAY 4: Goodbye to Sicily.

It has been a great time here in Sicily and we have got the chance of experiencing it in many different ways...we have our buffet breakfast at the hotel and check out to transfer to the airport. We say goodbye to everybody, carrying with us the stunning views of these days on the Island!

ITALY Sicily Format Sicily & Malta event

Discover two Islands of the Mediterranean with a common root!

A journey through culture, food and environment enriching your soul, flavoured by team building activities to aggregate and amuse your guests.

DAY 1: Welcome to Sicily.

At your arrival at the **Palermo** Airport, welcome by our staff. We shall transfer by motor coach to our centrally located hotel in the city. Our check in will be accompanied by a welcome drink. After check in we shall give free time to our guests in order to relax and get acquainted with their rooms. In the evening we meet in the lobby and proceed to our welcome dinner at the hotel, with an accurate menu. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 2: Discover Palermo and Monreale with our photographic hunt!

In the morning you will be greeted at the hotel by our tour leader to reach firstly Monreale by motor coach, where we shall meet our game leaders, introducing the guests to our special activity for today, a photographic hunt. The group will be split in teams and each team will receive the gaming material then we'll start the game! We shall walk into the city following the instructions given and, along the road, we shall meet our entertainers; while doing so, we shall discover the most famous but also the hidden places of **Monreale**. Monreale is home to a stunning Cathedral from Byzantine time, with its marvellous golden mosaics ceilings, and the city is strictly bond to the history of Sicily. After a couple of hours activity we'll get back to the hotel for lunch. After lunch we leave the hotel for the second part of the game, taking us to the discovery of **Palermo**, the vibrant capital city of Sicily in 2 more hours circa! We shall walk along the most famous roads (Via Maqueda, Via Roma...), the most famous monuments and the typical narrow alleys, still meeting our entertainers to give a special light to all we see! At the end, we shall reach our hotel again and have free time to freshen up and to dress up for tonight's dinner, in a special place in Palermo, which we shall reach by motor coach. Our dinner will be special, with a very accurate menu and excellent Sicilian wines! After dinner we drive back to the hotel for overnight.

DAY 3: The Roman Mosaics and the Pearl of the Mediterranean.

After breakfast we check out and meet our tour leader and driver to be taken to the first of our destinations of the day: **Piazza Armerina**, home to some of the finest Roman Mosaics in the Mediterranean area. The remains of the villa in which they are set used to belong to a very rich merchant and they still reveal all the opulence and luxury of the roman time. The quality and subjects of the mosaics are stunning! After visiting this excellent archaeological site with a local official guide we shall move further to a Baglio in the area; the Baglio is a typical rural structure which used to be the productive centre of old noblemen families of Sicily.

Nowadays they produce wine and we shall start by visiting their vineyards and cantina.

We then move to their restaurant and have lunch accompanied by the locally produced excellent wine. After lunch we shall move further to our destination, **Taormina**. Check in with a refreshing drink at our hotel and a short free time to freshen up. Right after we shall meet our local official guide and have access to the Roman-Greek Theatre of Taormina. We shall continue with the visit of Taormina, a nice late afternoon walk through its romantic alleys, and then we stroll to a fine local restaurant and have a nice welcome dinner. After dinner we reach our hotel and gather our energies, tomorrow we are going to visit one of the most famous wonders of Sicily!

DAY 4: Fire and Wine!

Being in Taormina we are at a stone throw from one of Sicily's major wonders: **Etna volcano!**

After breakfast, assisted by our tour leader, we'll be picked up by our jeep drivers to be taken to the volcano, along regular and off-road tracks. We shall see the wild side of the volcano, with its spectacular views and massive eruptions from the far and recent past, into woods and through lunar landscapes. We then continue to a large winery on the Etna slopes, where we shall go for a guided visit to the producing and aging area, ending at the degustation area where they'll serve us a fine **wine tasting** along with a fine lunch. Afterward we have settled a nice activity for our guests: a bottling activity, the old fashioned way! After this nice activity it will be time to



drive back to the hotel to freshen up and dress up for Sicily's gala dinner. We shall leave the hotel at dinner time and reach a fine ancient villa in the area, at a few minute drive: here we have prepared a gala dinner with an excellent menu, superior wines and a gala dinner show with a presenter, live shows, live music, to make our last night in Sicily really unforgettable! After dinner we return to the hotel to rest before leaving Sicily toward **Malta**. If requested, we can also have a cameraman following the group in Palermo and during gala dinner, enabling us to producing a video DVD of both events.

DAY 5: Goodbye Sicily - Welcome to Malta.

In the morning, after breakfast, we check out and transfer to **Catania** for an own exploration of the city centre by illustrated material supplied by us (our tour leader will assist you where necessary), which shall also include free time for shopping, then stop for lunch in a cosy local restaurant for a very typical Sicilian lunch! After lunch a nice digestivo (amaro, or grappa) and then, slowly, we transfer to the Catania International Airport, in order to check in and catch our plane to **Malta**.

DAY 5: Arrival in Malta - welcome again!!!!

Welcome and assistance by our Tour Guide at Malta International Airport and followed by direct transfer to the Hotel. Non Alcoholic **Welcome Drink** during separate Checking Desk at Hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 6: The Fugitives.

In the morning, after breakfast, we'll offer to our group a half day team building programme in Valletta, the guests will be involved in the research of some fugitives that ran away after stealing a precious object! The group is divided into teams, supplied with gaming materials, all teams competing with the others to find, identify and return the fugitives to captivity.

It is also possible that we extend the duration in **Valletta** so as to give the group time at leisure and also to keep on discovering Malta's Capital at their own pace.

DAY 7: Full Day – Prehistoric.

Departure from hotel in coach accompanied by our Tour Guide, we transfer to the south to visit Hagar Qim temple which is unique among the **Maltese** temples. Just a short walking distance away we will be able to see the Mnajdra Temple, down the hill from Hagar Qim.

We then drive to Wied iz-Zurrieq which is also a small fishing village. Subject to weather permitting we may take a small fishing boat to visit the Blue Grotto Cave which can be reached only by sea. The cave is 40 metres in circumference and reaches a depth of 26 metres. The Blue **Grotto** faces east and it is at its best in the morning because the sunrays floodlight the entire grotto revealing its beauty. In the afternoon we drive to Marsaxlokk which is Malta's largest village. Here one will be able to watch the fishermen mending their nets or painting their boats but above all admire this quaint village full of typical colourful fishing boats. (On Sunday morning there is a lively market). Finally we drive to **Birzebbugia** to visit Ghar Dalam which is a 144 metres long natural cave. The cave is renowned for the remains of animals that lived on the island thousands of years ago. The massive stalactites and stalagmites, which it contains, reveal its very great antiquity. Back to the hotel and free time.

In the evening, departure from hotel by coach to the Old Capital - Mdina. Upon arrival group will be welcomed by an entourage of artists (actors, musicians, torchbearers) in costume .

They will greet and escort them through the narrow streets of **Mdina** until they reach Bastions Square where they are served aperitifs, giving guests time to enjoy their aperitifs as much as the panorama. The ceremonials can also be extended during dinner. Then the master of ceremonies invites our guests to follow him towards the selected restaurant. Dine in truly romantic surroundings beneath the flowering Oleander tree in the vine clustered courtyard during the summer, and by candle-light and an open log fireplace that keeps the restaurant warm during the winter months.
